

PERENNIALS

Glacier Nursery, Inc. offers a wide variety of perennials and ground covers that are acclimated to our northern climate. All plants are fully established and rooted into the media, with roots to the edge of the plastic container. Our potting media contains soil that retains moisture and nutrients that produce a plant ready for immediate resale or planting into the landscape. The majority of varieties come standard in 1 gallon containers, but some are also available in 3½" pots (18 per tray), 2 gallon, or 5 gallon containers. Perennials in the larger containers are full, mature plants, which are great for planting into landscapes where large sized, immediate impact plants are desired. Please note the container size is trade designation only. In preparation for shipping, perennials that are in flower are inserted individually into a paper sleeve for protection.

For pricing, we consider the species of the plant and also the size of the container. The individual price per plant is based upon the number ordered and delivered at one time to the same location. The item ordered and delivered must be of the same species, same container size, and same plant size to receive the quantity pricing. Price breaks are offered at quantities of five, twenty-five, and one hundred. Only select items receive 25 or 100 & up pricing. Quantity column headings at the top of each page help you price your plants accordingly.

On pages 96 and 97 is a chart listing flowering months, sun and soil tolerances of the perennials we offer. This will enable you to plan a perennial garden with full season appeal.

Most of the perennials we sell are overwintered at our nursery or have been grown in the pot in which they are sold for two months or more. Occasionally we will purchase perennials for resale to supplement our plant availability. We pay strict attention to our sources both for plant quality and for compatibility to our climate. If you have any questions regarding the source of a plant purchased from Glacier Nursery, Inc. feel free to ask us and we are more than willing to share that information with you.

**Achillea millefolium 'Summer Pastel', Summer Pastels Yarrow** 24"h x 30"w, full sun      Zone 3  
A perennial that has an array of color. Flowers with a mixture of white, yellow, orange, red, and purple shades of color. Foliage is a dark green, different than our other Achillea. Excellent plant for massing.

**Achillea x 'Moonshine', Moonshine Yarrow** 24"h x 30"w, full sun      Zone 3  
Bright yellow flowers with silvery foliage. Long lasting flowers, vigorous growth. Flowers through the summer.

**Achillea x 'Paprika', Paprika Yarrow** 24"h x 30"w, full sun      Zone 3  
Intense red flower clusters with small yellow centers, green foliage. Long lasting flowers. Very dramatic when massed. Summer flowering.

Low, dense mass of white edged foliage, spreads by underground stolons. An indestructible ground cover. Flowers in early summer.

**Ajuga reptans 'Bronze Beauty', Bronze Beauty Ajuga** 6-8"h, partial to full shade      Zone 3  
Strong growing perennial forms a tight mat in a spreading habit. Bronze foliage and blue flower spikes. It is an excellent ground cover with an attractive flower in early summer.

**NEW!** *Ajuga reptans* '**Catlin's Giant**', **Catlin's Giant Ajuga** 6-10"h, partial to full shade Zone 3  
A larger form of Ajuga with 6" purple and green foliage. Creates a dense ground cover with purple flower spikes in early summer.

*Aquilegia*, **Columbines** 12-24"h x 18"w, full to partial sun Zone 3  
Attractive foliage that is good for massing.

**Blue** - White centers with blue petals.

**Red** - White centers with red petals.

A variety of (pastel) spurred flowers in early summer. Self-sows easily and not always true to parent color.

Dwarf flowers that are sky-blue with white centers. Welcome nectar for butterflies and hummingbirds. Suitable for rock gardens.

*Arabis alpina* '**Compinkie**', **Compinkie Rockcress** 8"h, short spreading habit, full to partial sun Zone 3  
Numerous small pink flowers above delicate foliage. Compact growing plant suitable for rock gardens. Early spring flowering. Deadhead after flowering.

*Arabis alpina* '**Snow Cap**', **Snow Cap Rockcress** 8"h, short spreading habit, full to partial sun Zone 3  
Profusion of small white flowers above delicate foliage. Compact growing plant suitable for rock gardens. Early spring flowering. Deadhead after flowering.

*Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*, **Kinnikinick** 2-3"h x 36-48"w, full to partial shade Zone 3  
Low growing evergreen type makes this a good ground cover. The foliage turns red in the fall/winter months. Native plant. Useless information that will make you smarter: Did you know that the word Kinnikinick is the longest word in the English language that is pronounced the same way backward and forwards?

**NEW!** *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi* '**Massachusetts**', **Massachusetts Kinnikinick** 12"h x 10-15"w Zone 3  
Full to partial shade. This type of Kinnikinick looks similar to the native type listed above although this selection is slightly taller. Flowers pink in late spring and foliage turns from green to red/orange in the fall/winter months.

*Armeria maritima* '**Splendens**', **Splendens Sea Pink** 6"h x 8"w, full sun Zone 3  
Grassy tufts of foliage with small pink allium (ball or globe) type flowers held aloft on short stems in the summer.

Silvery foliage, best used as a contrast to other plants. Benefits from being cut back at least once during the summer.

Lavender flowers from bushy mounds of foliage. Fantastic fall color as it flowers late, August & September until frost. Extremely showy!

Feathery spiked flowers, prefer moist conditions, especially in full sun, will do best in partial shade. Fern like foliage. Flowers in the summer.

Dainty yellow flowers borne above vigorous foliage. Flowers early in season, and a second time if deadheaded and trimmed back slightly.

**Bergenia cordifolia, Heartleaf Bergenia** 12", partial sun Zone 3  
Heart shaped glossy leaf with stalks of pink flowers in the spring. Useful as a border plant and tolerates moisture.

**Buddleia davidii 'Black Knight', Black Knight Butterfly Bush** 4-6' full sun Zone 5/6  
A vigorous grower with dark purple flowers late in the summer. A good cut flower. Root hardy to zone 4.

One inch bell shaped flowers cover the low mound of foliage in mid summer. Good for rock gardens and edging.

**Campanula punctata 'Cherry Bells', Cherry Bells Bellflower** 18-20", full to partial sun Zone 3  
Big cherry-red bell shaped flowers hang from the stems through the summer. A unique look for borders or a cut flower.

**Centaurea montana, Mountain Bluet** 24"h x 24"w, full sun Zone 3  
Vivid indigo-blue, feathery flowers standing out against silky leaves. Good for cut flowers. Has a tendency to seed itself in the garden. Flowers in spring.

**Cerastium tomentosum, Snow in Summer** 3-6"h x spreading habit, full sun Zone 3  
Hardy, creeping perennial with grayish, downy foliage and abundant white flowers in early spring. Tucked into a rock wall, they give the appearance of a snowdrift when in full flower. Good ground cover.

**NEW! Clematis integrifolia 'Caerulea', Bushy Blue Bell Clematis** 1-2'h x 2-3'w, full to partial sun Zone 3  
Unlike the other climbing Clematis, this one has a bushy habit. Charming violet-purple bell shaped flowers adorn this herbaceous perennial throughout the summer.

**Coreopsis 'Baby Sun', Baby Sun Coreopsis** 12"h x 12"w, full sun Zone 4  
Bright yellow flowers with red centers above leafy foliage. Abundant flowers throughout the summer.

A distinctive golden yellow fluted flower sets this one apart from the others. Flowers crest the compact mound of foliage throughout the summer.

Pink flowers float on mounds of finely cut foliage in late summer. Late to emerge in spring, you may want to mark their location in the fall.

**Coreopsis verticillata 'Moonbeam', Moonbeam Coeopsis** 12-24"h x 24"w, full sun Zone 3  
Delicate fern-like foliage with long lasting, pale yellow daisy-like flowers with vivid color throughout the summer. Drought tolerant.

**NEW! Delosperma 'Mesa Verde', Ice Plant** 2"h, full to partial sun Zone 4  
This compact low growing perennial has beautiful salmon-pink flowers all summer long. Makes this a wonderful addition to any garden.

**Delphinium 'Magic Fountains', Magic Fountains Larkspur** 24-30"h, full sun Zone 3  
The classic cottage garden flower. Handsome spikes of mixed colors from white to pink to blue that provide a striking backdrop in the perennial garden. May require staking and protection from wind as the stalks, stems are fragile. Flowers in mid-summer.

- Dianthus deltoides 'Brilliant', Maiden Pink** 6-8"h, full sun Zone 3  
Spreading mats of narrow leafed foliage producing hundreds of vivid red to fuchsia flowers in early summer. Excellent ground cover.

Pink double flowers spring through frost. Mounded gray/green foliage remains evergreen. Good for rock gardens.
